

CORDWOOD CONSTRUCTION WORKSHOP

2 day Cordwood Construction Workshop near Asheville, NC

October 10-11, 2009

Where: The workshop will be held at the home of Richard & Angela which is south of Asheville, NC. The site is at a rural home and is a few miles north of Hendersonville.

When: Workshops run from 9 am to 5 pm. There will be a social on Saturday evening (weather permitting).

Who: The instructors for this workshop will be Richard and Becky Flatau, of Cordwood Construction Resources LLC, Merrill, WI. They have 26 years experience in conducting cordwood workshops, individual/couple mortaring sessions and training work crews on cordwood job sites.

What: Each day is a mix of classroom and hands-on work. Classroom sessions include general cordwood information, power point presentations, and discussions of the various styles of cordwood houses, as well as the various species of wood (and how long to dry them). Hands-on sessions include demonstrations by the instructors, and plenty of individually supervised hands-on practice by the students. **The workshop project will be 18” cordwood infilling of post and beam framed greenhouse.** High quality-control assures that the students learn visually pleasing techniques, as well as structurally sound and energy-efficient construction methods.

Safety: This workshop is at a building construction site and registrants must be aware of the subsequent safety issues. Children must register and be supervised by their parents. Please call for details if you plan to register children.

Meals: Lunches are included in the tuition cost of the workshop. Breakfast and dinner are *not* provided. There are good places to eat in and around Asheville. You will be provided with a comprehensive list. Campers, of course, may prefer to prepare their own meals.

Accommodations: *An Information Package ...* is sent out in early summer, with a keyed map to the workshop location. Information about restaurants, B & B's, motels, and campgrounds in the area will be *sent as soon as we receive your registration confirmation.* Tuition does not include accommodations.

Registration: Enrollment will be limited to the first 16 people registered for the workshop. At least one half of the total workshop tuition must accompany the Pre-Registration Form to hold your space. The balance can be paid at formal registration at 8:30 a.m. on the first day of the workshop.

Tuition: The tuition fee for this special 2-day workshop is \$200 for an individual, or \$360 for a couple. Lunches are provided on both workshop days, and good quality work gloves are given free to each student. We supply all necessary tools. Cordwood books and plans will be available for sale at the workshop. Go to www.daycreek.com/flatau for a complete listing of books and plans.

Textbook: The suggested textbook for the workshop is *Cordwood Construction: A Log End View 2009* (\$22). It will help prepare you for the cordwood workshop and give you the necessary data to make good decisions when making the many necessary choices for your cordwood project.
